ÉCOLE SAINTE-CATHERINE

The Board received an official letter from school council requesting the progression to Grade 4. The Board unanimously voted to approve the request and have Sainte-Catherine offer a Pre-K to Grade 4 program for the 2016-2017 school year.

2016 - 2017 SCHOOL CALENDAR

Marc Dumont, Superintendent, stated that there was good feedback from staff when administration shared the draft calendars for review. What emerged from the feedback was a request to change the holiday periods to match those of neighboring school boards. The Board, in favor of the changes, adopted the new 2016-2017 school calendar as presented by administration.

2010 - 2015 FINANCIAL PROFILE

Marc Labonté, Secretary-Treasurer, explained that this document is created each year to summarize the school boards' financial profile in comparison with other boards. The profile highlights that CSCE is doing well in this regard with an accumulated surplus of 3.37%.
